- 7. Promotion is granted on the basis of the Whole year's performance of the student.
- 8. No re-test is permitted.
- 9. CBSE has initiated Assessment of Speaking & Listening Skills (ASL) for classes in IX –XII to focus on communicative aspects of language learning & problems based on higher order reasoning skills.
